Subsidy Program for Children's Medical Expense

This program helps cover the medical expenses incurred by children. City of Funabashi provides 'Subsidy Certificate for Children's Medical Expense' to children who are eligible. Present both this certificate and your health insurance card at a medical institution in Chiba prefecture. The amount to be paid individually will be settled and you only have to pay your part (300 yen or free of charge).

Subsidy Program

Eligible children are those who registered in Funabashi and join the Japanese health insurance plan. This program subsidizes only the expenses covered by the Japanese health insurance.

- Free of charge for the municipal tax-exempt households due to the income bracket.
- Expenses not covered by the Japanese health insurance are exempt from this program.
 E.g.) Health checkup/ Immunization/ Fee for medicine's containers/ Fee for documents/ Charges for hospital beds not covered by health insurance

♦ How to request refunds when the subsidy certificate is not acceptable (Reimbursements)

You have to pay all your own medical expenses when your children visited medical institutes outside of Chiba prefecture or when your children were seen to by a doctor without subsidy certificates. However, you can get a refund for health insurance treatments by applying for it later. Please note that the application is valid only for 2 years after the day subsequent to your payment at the hospital.

[Flow of procedures]

- ①Submit an application form and the receipt to the City.
- *Other documents are required when you paid 100% medical expenses or you made spectacles for a weak-sighted person and supportive devices. Please ask for details.
- ②A Subsidy will be transferred to guardian's bank account after examination.
- *When the City sends the subsidy certificate later, a letter written about required documents for reimbursements will be enclosed. Please have a look for details.
