# The "My Number" Individual Number system will begin January 2016.

#### Individual Number mailing has begun in October 2015.

- The Individual Numbers (My Number) are each one unique to its holder.
- They are required for procedures at municipal offices, etc. instead of Resident Register Code (*Juminhyo* Code).
- From October 2015 on, your municipality will mail an envelope below to your residence (at the address registered therewith).
- The envelope contains a "Notification Card" with your Individual Number on it.

# "Individual Number Cards" will be available!

- Your "Individual Number Card" also serves as an ID card bearing your Individual Number.
- To apply for it, fill in and send back the application provided with the "Notification Card."
- You can also apply for it through your smart phone and web.



# Handle your Individual Number with care!

- Keep your Notification Card at hand and be careful not to throw it away or tear it.
- To avoid illegitimate use of your Individual Number, do not tell it to others except as required.
